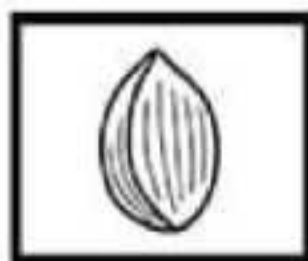
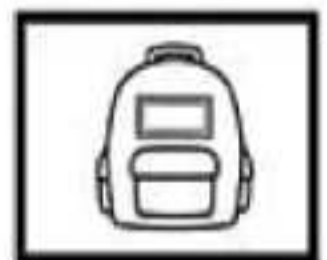
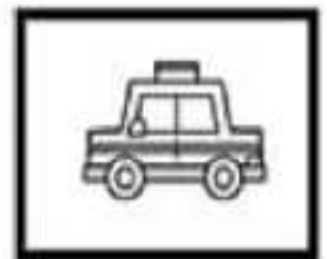
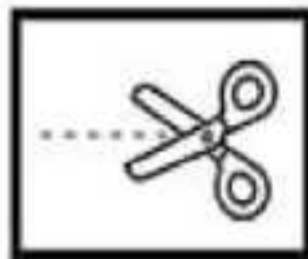
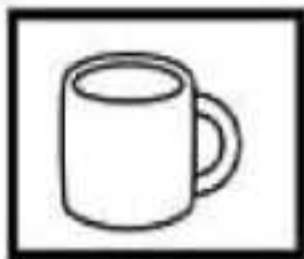
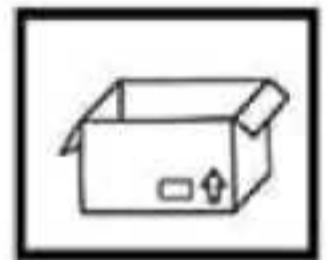
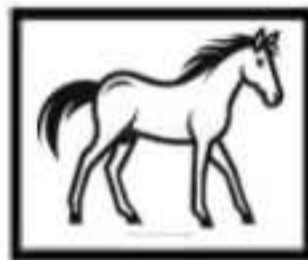
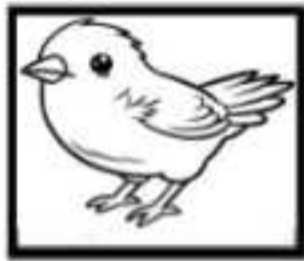
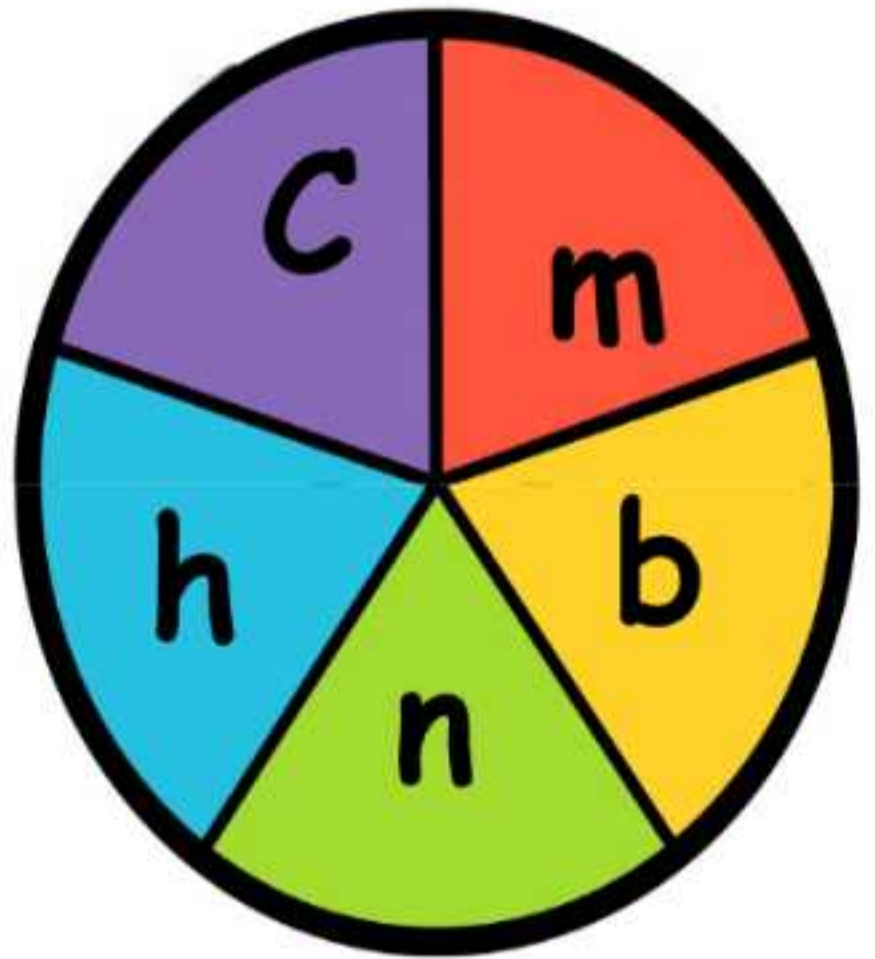
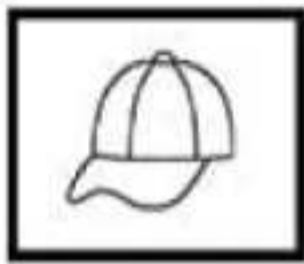
Dear Parents,

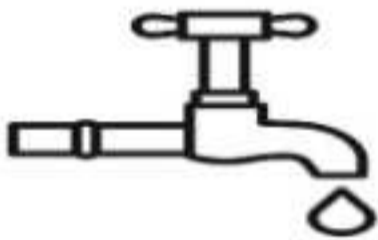




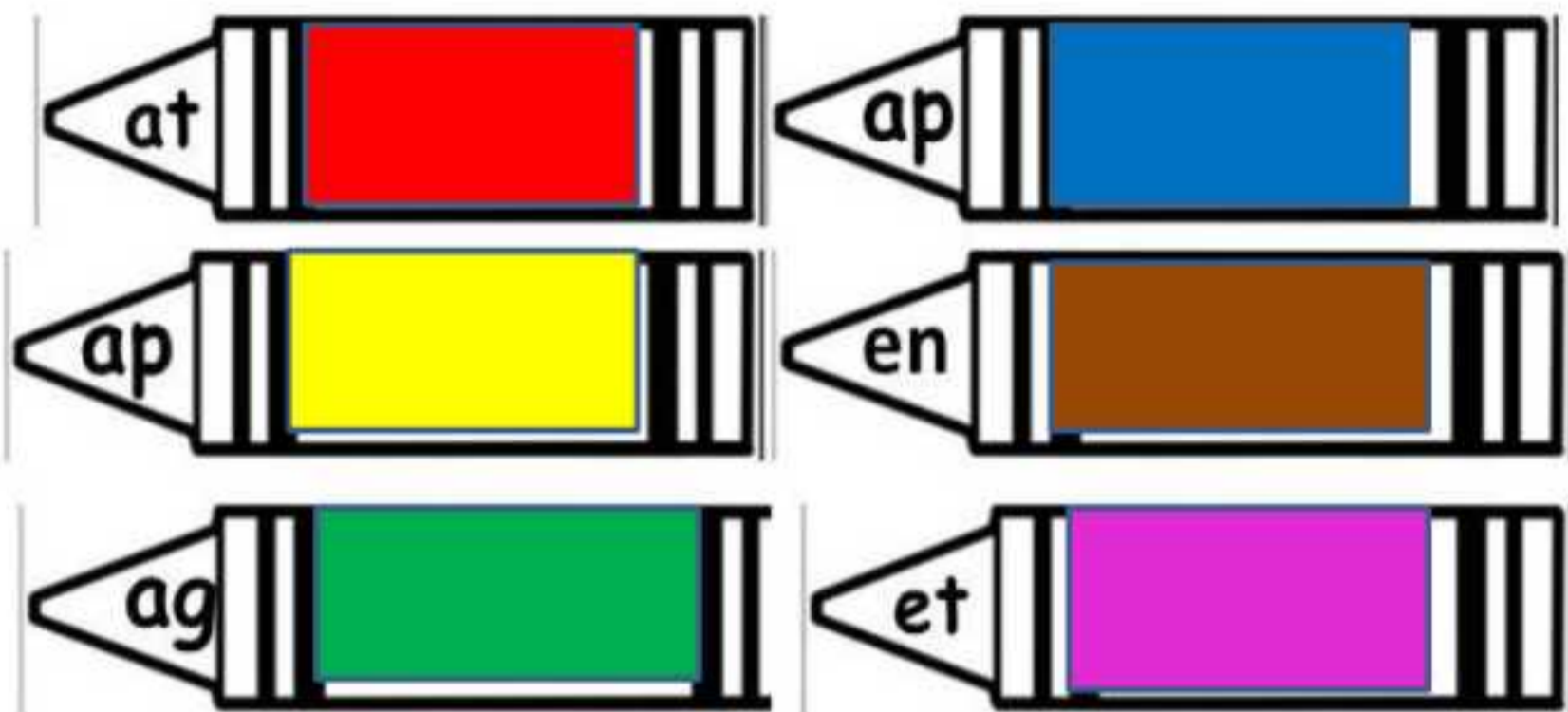

*Fold the papers in half to make a small book.

*Staple or tie the folded side to bind the book.

*Draw or paste picture on the first page for the cover and give your story a title.

*On each page, draw/paste pictures about your story.

*Decorate and design your storybook using your imagination and creativity. Cover it with plastic to protect it from tears and damage.

*Bring your storybook with you to read and share with your classmates during DEAR Time.

Instructions: *Take a A3 Size paper, paste on a card board and draw a colourful path (like a race track or boxes from start to finish).

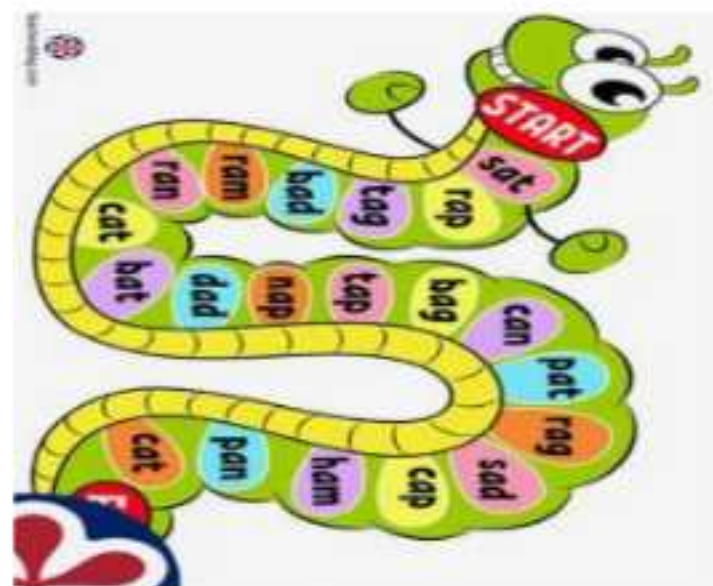
*Write or paste flash cards of a & e vowel words in some boxes along the path.

*Rotate the top circle to form new words.

Instructions:*Take 4-5 small sheets of paper, stack them together and paste on A3 sheet on distance to make a flip calendar

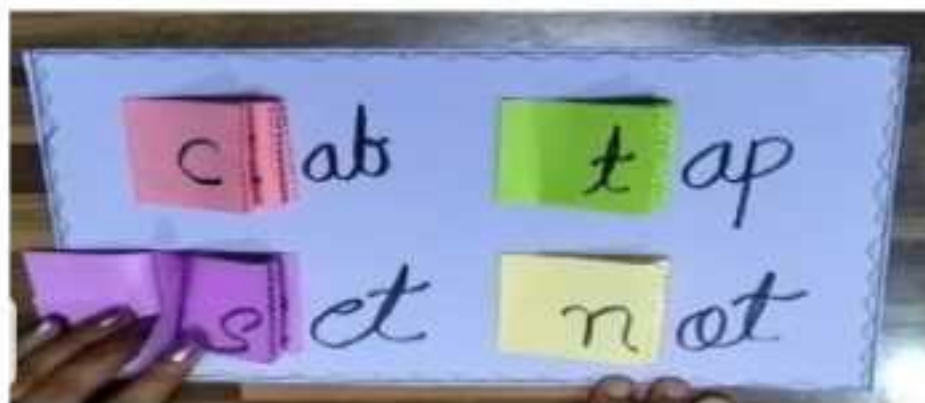
*Staple, paste or bind them at the top.

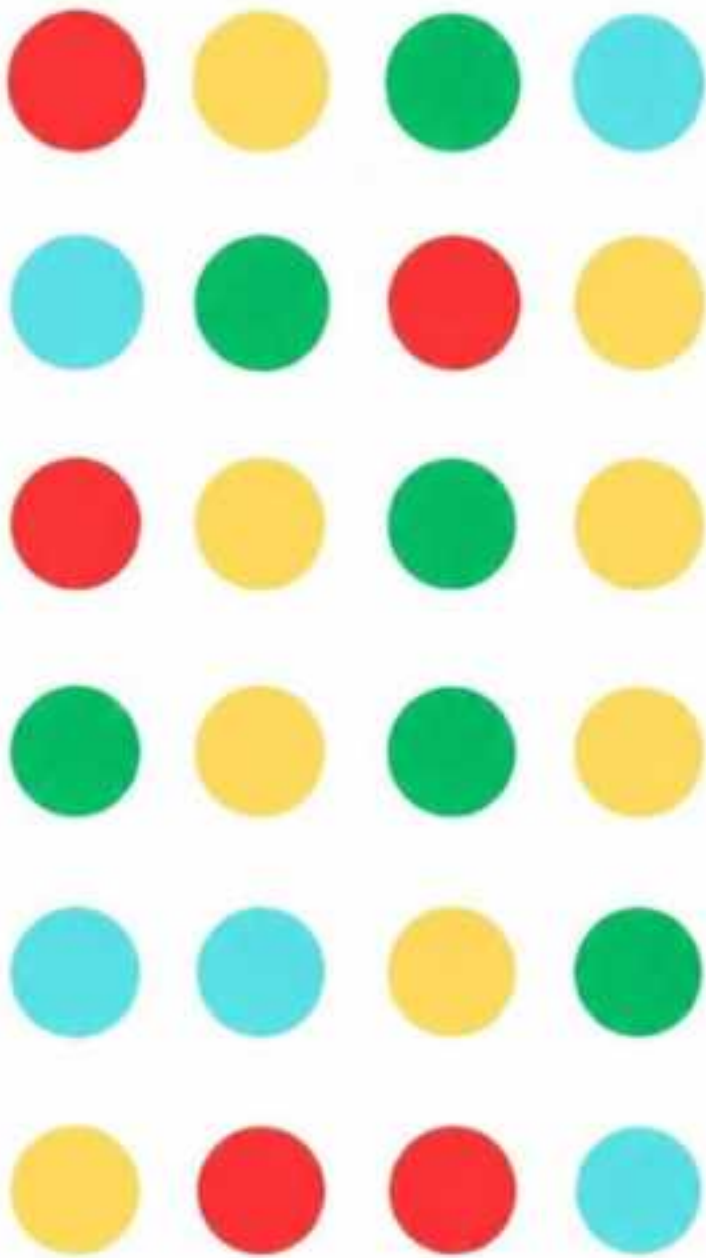

The exact measurement of every side should be **12 cm**.

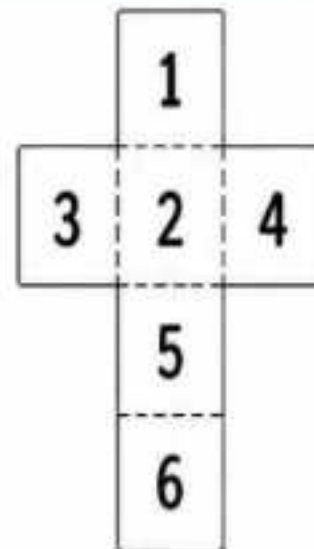
