Instructions:

- Write 6–8 meaningful lines expressing your feelings/self composed poem
- Include:
 - Thankfulness for their love and care
 - Something special they do for you
 - Your feelings (happy, lucky, proud, thankful)
 - A small promise (to help, respect, or make them proud)
- Decorate your card neatly with colours, borders, and drawings

Example:

I am very thankful to you for always taking care of me. You support me in everything I do and make me feel safe and happy. I feel lucky to have you in my life. I promise to always respect you and make you proud.

Part B: 3D Gratitude Tree (A3 Sheet)

Create a 3D Gratitude Tree on an A3 sheet.

Instructions:

- Design a 3D tree using paper folding, cut-outs, or layering
- Make it colourful, neat, and creative
- Add 15–20 leaves (draw or paste)

What to write on each leaf:

- One gratitude word
- Its meaning
- One simple sentence

Example (one leaf):

Word: Kindness

Meaning: Being caring and helpful

Sentence: We should show kindness to animals and people.

Assessment Rubrics:- Content: Clear, meaningful, and thoughtful ideas
Creativity: Use of colours, 3D elements, and originality
Language: Correct and simple sentences
Presentation: Neatness and proper layout
Effort: Completeness and sincerity

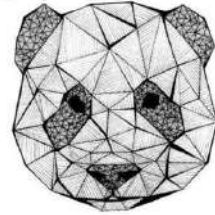

Concepts Covered: Symmetry, Shapes, Counting, Patterns

Materials Required: Paper plate or chart paper, colors, scissors, glue

Tasks:

Design a face mask using only geometric shapes

Ensure both sides of the mask are symmetrical

Count how many circles, triangles, and squares used

Create a repeating pattern on the border

Identify the line of symmetry.

2. Fun with tables (Accordion Booklet)

Steps:

- Divide into 9 equal vertical sections
- Fold in zig-zag (accordion style)
- Each fold = one table, write and learn tables from 12 to 20.

1. *My Family Page*

- Paste pictures of your family members
- For each member, write:
 - Values you learn from them
 - How they support and care for you

2. *Gratitude Section* (What I receive from my family)

- Write 5-6 lines expressing thankfulness
- Mention love, care and support

3. *Responsibility Section* (What I will do for my family)

- Write 5-6 points about your role in the family
(*e.g. helping at home, respecting elders etc.*)

4. *Prayer Section (My prayer for my family)*

- Write a self-composed prayer (5-6 lines)
- Express wishes for happiness, health and well-being

Presentation:

- Design the cover page of the folder creatively
- Give a clear title: “*My Family - Gratitude in Action*”
- Each section should be on a separate page inside the folder
- Add simple illustrations for every section

Social Science

2. Comic Strip - “Kindness in Action”

TASK:

Create a comic strip showing a situation where someone shows kindness, empathy or inclusion towards others.

- The comic strip should have 6-8 panels
- Use drawings and speech bubbles to show conversations
- Present a clear flow: Problem → Kind action → Positive outcome
- Add a short message at the end related to kindness or inclusion

Suggested Themes:

- Inclusive Education: Helping or including a child with different abilities in class activities
- Social Inclusion: Welcoming a new student or including someone who feels left out
- Helping Others: Supporting people in need or showing care towards others
- Kindness in Daily Life: Respecting elders, sharing or helping at home/school

Specific Instructions for Students:

- Use your own ideas and avoid copying
- Keep drawings simple, neat and meaningful
- Focus on real-life situations
- Creativity is encouraged in presentation and storytelling
